Student Right to Know Disclosure

Lamson Institute seeks to provide its current and prospective student with valuable information about the success of students who enter our institution. In keeping with the requirements of the student Right to Know Act, the school provides a disclosure regarding the graduation, completion and transfer-out-rates of its students to all students and prospective students annually.

The graduation rate in this disclosure is determined by establishing a cohort of full-time, first-time students who enrolled during the 2012-2013 Academic Year (July 1, 2012 through June 30th, 2013), and then tracking them through a period of time that equals one and one-half times the normal time it takes to complete the longest program in the cohort. At the end of the tracking period, the school determines which students have completed their program. The resulting percentage is then provided.

Graduation/Completion Rate

For the Academic Year 2012-2013, there were 390 full-time, first-time students who were enrolled during that period. As of July 2014, 370 students in the cohort (or 95%) had completed their programs within 150% of the time it normally takes a full-time student to complete their program.

Transfer-Out Rate

Because the mission of our school does not include providing substantial preparation for our students to enroll in another eligible school (as would be the case for most community or junior colleges), our school is not required to calculate a transfer-out rate.
